### Investigate vendors' and buyers' development gaps

Conduct research to identify knowledge, capacity, and resource gaps faced by both social enterprises and public authorities in the SPP context.

### Ensure the sustainability of project results

Develop valuable resources, including a Handbook for VET providers, a MOOC for wider accessibility, a digital tool for assessing social enterprise readiness, and policy briefs integrating project outcomes into national policies.

### Overcome blocking points through innovative vocational training and learning tools

Deliver an innovative "Social Procurement Expert" curriculum addressing identified needs, combining classroom instruction with practical work-based learning experiences involving social enterprises & public authorities.
